MINUTES –APRIL 24, 2025 Dave Blair made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Timothy Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.

PAID BILLS – APRIL 24, 2025-MAY 27, 2025 Timothy Bruce made a motion to approve the bills paid. Motion was seconded by Christopher O'Connor and passed by unanimous voice vote.

ALPARON PARK BOARD APPOINTMENT (LETTER) A letter confirming the appointment of Timothy Bruce to the Alparon Community Park Board was presented for Council Present's signature.

POLICE FT HIRE -CHIEF WIBIRT & PER-DIEM The Manager reported that Brian Wibirt was sworn in on May 12th as the full-time Police Chief for Troy Borough. Officers Ralph Dooley and Kyle Wisel will both be working per-diem.

STREET REPAIR QUOTE – On a motion by David Blair, seconded by Christopher O'Connor Council accepted a quote for street repairs in the amount of \$12,800 submitted by Solid Ground Services. Areas to be repaired are from water line repairs over the winter.

MA LOAN / GRIT PROJECT – A loan Agreement in the amount of \$90,495 from the Municipal Authority to Troy Borough to assist with the Grit Project at the Waste Water Treatment Plant was presented. Steve Lambert made a motion to accept the agreement. The motion was seconded by David Blair and passed by unanimous voice vote.

GRIT PROJECT – COMPLETE & OPERATIONAL – It was reported that the Grit Removal System has been completed and is now fully operational

PROSPECT BRIDGE REIMBURSMENT AGREEMENT – A Reimbursement Agreement between PA-DOT and Troy Borough in the amount of \$670,000 has been executed for repairs to the Prospect Street Bridge

BRIDGE GRANTS YTD (S.R.R. / REDINGTON) – Bridge grant funding received and disbursed for the South Railroad Street and Redington Avenue bridges to date is \$ 444,483.69

STORM WATER & BRIDGE REPAIRS – The Manager gave a brief report on buried storm lines and catch basins that have been installed to eliminate open ditches and an update on the time line status for bridge construction. (S. Railroad & Redington)

DAVISON GREEN ACTIVITY – The Chamber of Commerce provided a letter to Council requesting the use of Davison Green for a planned activity on June 21st, 2025. The letter also requested that the Council waive the fee for yard sale permits on that same date for a community wide yard sale. Christopher O'Connor made a motion to waive the requirement for yard sale permits for that day and to authorize use of the Green by the Chamber for the scheduled event. The motion was seconded by Timothy Bruce and passed by a unanimous voice vote. Council President Jason Hodlofski asked the Manager to set up a committee meeting to develop standards for future use of Davison Green by requesting entities.
