Meeting was opened with the salute to the flag

- **MINUTES** – the minutes of the September 26th, 2024 meeting were approved by a unanimous voice vote following a motion to approve by councilman Bruce and seconded by councilman Raub.
- **PAID BILLS** – The bills were approved by unanimous voice vote following a motion by councilman Bruce seconded by councilman Blair. The general fund ledger is attached

- **BRIDGE LOAD POSTING – Manager reported**
In a recent bridge inspection of the Redington avenue structure it was noted that the near advance bridge load posting was missing. The sign must have been removed by clean-up crews after the storm took down a tree that knocked out the electric service to the boroughs well house. The replacement has been ordered. When replaced the critical deficiency correction report will be sent to Penn-Dot and Larson Design as required.
- **CHAPTER 94 LETTER**
THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMPLETED THE REVIEW OF THE BOROUGH'S 2023 ANNUAL WASTELOAD MANAGEMENT REPORT AS REQUIRED BY 25 PA. CODE § 94.12. THE REPORT IS CONSIDERED ACCEPTABLE
- **FINANCIALS**
General fund balances are up from January by \$185,000. Gen cap reserve is up \$10,761. Water funds are up \$2,386 and water cap reserve is down \$45,969. Sewer funds are up \$59,789 and sewer cap reserve is up \$1,473
- **HEALTH BENEFIT GRID**
While reviewing the health benefit grid the Asst Manager noticed that telemedicine services were not covered. After contacting Benecon those services were included as covered 100% after \$5.00 copay. Telemedicine was covered under the PPO that we no longer have and was somehow overlooked on the HMO plan.
- **PLANNING BOARD**
There is an open seat on the planning commission board following the resignation of Zachary Gates. We received a letter of intent from Tyler Woodward indicating a desire to be on that board. We advertised in the Daily Review notifying residents to submit a letter of intent if interested by October 28. No other letters were submitted. You have had the opportunity to review Mr. Woodward's letter. Councilman Blair made a motion

to appoint Mr. Woodward. The motion was seconded by councilman Raub and passed by unanimous voice vote.

- **BOND INSURANCE**

We have received continuation certificates for the Assistant Managers bond in the amount of \$100,000 and the Managers bond in the amount of \$500,000.

- **MEETING SCHEDULE**

The Manager reminded council that the November meeting is scheduled for the 21st because of thanksgiving. Same time and location with the exception that we will meet out in Repsol Hall instead of the Arena.

- **BANDSTAND**

The VFW brought forth a desire to make some renovations to the band stand. As the concept grew, and in light of the fact that the band stand is a borough owned property/structure it was decided to develop a committee representing the community. The committee is made up of one representative from the VFW, American legion, Chamber of Commerce, Historical Society, Lions Club and the Rotary club along with the Borough Manager. The committee asked the Manager to get a quote for architectural services for the project. The quote is attached describing the services to be provided, the total of which is \$ 14,000.00. Councilman Blair made a motion to accept and pay it out of Borough funds if the committee agrees to raise money for the cost of construction. The motion was seconded by councilman Raub. After considerable discussion the motion passed by a majority voice vote with councilman Davis voting nay.

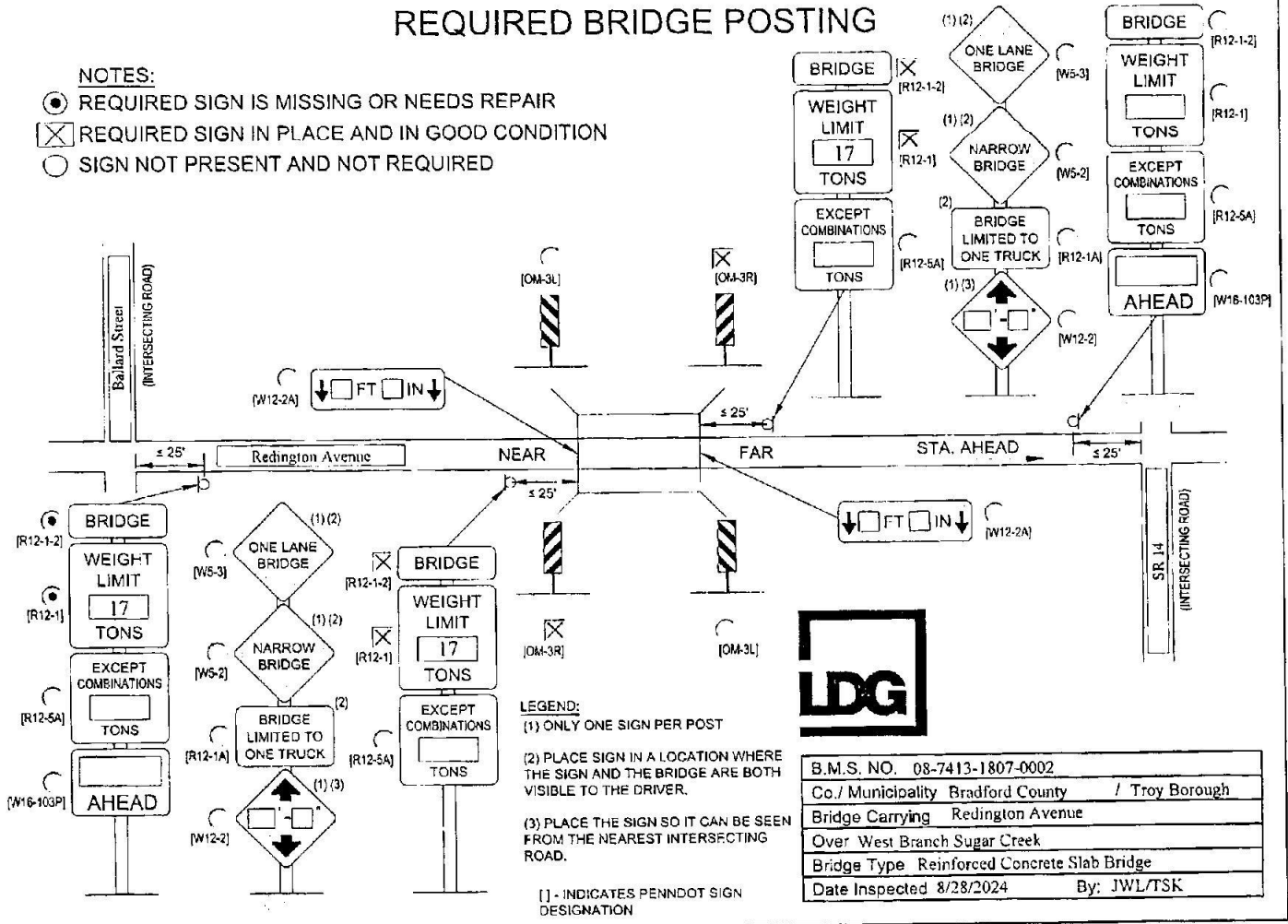

During the interim inspection for the referenced structure, the following critical deficiency was found:

The near advance Bridge Load Posting Assembly is missing.

LDG recommends that the following repair be completed immediately (within 7 days):

Install a new near Bridge Load Posting Assembly at the near advance location so that it is 5' above the roadway measured to the bottom of the signs.

Damaged, missing or incorrect load limit signs are examples where there may be no immediate structure safety problem, but where public safety is compromised, and immediate action is required.

(1) Your group's benefit period is based on a Calendar Year which runs from January 1 to December 31.

(2) The Network Total Maximum Out-of-Pocket (TMOOP) is mandated by the federal government. TMOOP must include deductible, coinsurance, copays, prescription drug cost share and any qualified medical expense.

(3) Telemedicine Services (acute care for minor illnesses available on-demand 24/7) must be performed by a Highmark Designated Telemedicine Provider. Additional services provided by a Designated Telemedicine Provider are paid according to the benefit category that they fall under (e.g. PCP is eligible under the PCP Office Visit benefit, Behavioral Health is eligible under the Outpatient Mental Health Services benefit).

(4) Services are limited to those listed on the Highmark Preventive Schedule with enhancements (Women's Health Preventive Schedule may apply).

I was finally able to connect with Syme about the WWTP expansion. Apparently his intention was to start closer to the end of November/beginning of December.

I reminded him that the Contract Documents state that the Contractor should start within 30 days of the signed Agreement (which would put the start date at 10/30).

He offered to have someone come out and start doing some demo work next week. My only concern there is that since the plant is currently in use, I don't know that you'll want to have them tearing up your parking lot and then leaving it sit for a month? It sounds like he's still confident that he can hit the substantial/final completion dates (180/210 days past the start date, or 4/28/25 and 5/28/25 respectively).

He doesn't technically need to start by 10/30, but the Contract dates do start then. So if he thinks he can hit the 4/28 and 5/28 dates, then we cant necessarily push him on it.

Maybe we can put our heads together next week and chat about it?
