- **Minutes January 30, 2025** Councilman Bruce made a motion approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Raub and passed by unanimous voice vote.
- **Paid Bills Approval** Motion to approve the bills paid was made by Councilman Blair. The motion was seconded by Councilman Davis and passed by unanimous voice vote. (attached)

Managers' Report

- **Water-Loss**
Our current water usage is over 500,000 GPD. It should be closer to 250,000 or less. We have had technical specialist in leak detection from PA-Rural water here a couple of times and have had a specialist in leak detection from a private contractor in twice. We found and repaired a 4" main line Leake in the alley behind Carson Finance and repaired 2 leaks on East Main Street. We identified and made repairs on two different laterals and will start on a leak found on Miller Terrace. We will continue our search and repair efforts going forward.
- **WWTP Expansion Update**
The enclosure for the screw conveyor is about 75% complete. Currently the electric control panels, conduit and wiring are about 25% complete. I feel that the substantial completion date of March 29, 2025 will be met. Following that is the completed and ready for final payment date of April 28th, 2025.
- **WWTP Return Pump Purchase**
The return / waste pump at the wwtp is making some noise that indicates it is about to be retired. We have a quote for a replacement of \$8,720.00. This is a costars certified quote under the Pennsylvania department of general services; therefore, no other

quotes are required. The last pump purchased and installed was 12 years ago at a cost of \$8,340 and that included an additional cost of \$1400.00 for an expedited build and ship. Councilman Raub made a motion to approve the purchase. The motion was seconded by Councilman Blair and passed by a unanimous voice vote. (quote attached)

- **Troy Sale Barn Retaining Wall Update**

The MA is funding the engineering work to stabilize the retaining wall behind the Sale Barn. At this point it looks like a footer for the wall would need to extend onto the property of the Presbyterian Church. I have reached out to one of the church officers and they have indicated they are ok with that.

- **Council Meeting Time**

Councilman Bruce made a motion to move the monthly meeting time to 6 PM. The motion was seconded by Councilman Raub. The motion passed by a majority voice vote.

- **Admin Asst / Asst Mngr. Hire**

By the end of the year, we will need to hire an Admin Asst /Asst. Mngr. The Personnel Committee has meet to review options. At this point I turn it over the Committee Chair Timothy Bruce. Following a brief discussion with the current Admin Asst/Asst. Mngr. as to required training time, Councilman Bruce made a motion to advertise for the position as described by Mrs. Randal, and to do so in the timeframe she felt appropriate. The motion was seconded by Councilman Blair and passed by unanimous voice vote.

- **Bridge Grant Funding YTD**

\$297,693.06

- **MA Loan Offer**

At the quarterly meeting (02/27/25) of the Municipal Authority the Board agreed to loan to the Borough, for completion of the waste water treatment plant expansion project (grit removal), \$90,902.99 for 36 months (432 monthly payments) at 1% annual interest. The Borough will pay the remaining cost of the project (\$129,067.14) from a federal grant received. Steve Lambert made a motion to accept the loan offer. The motion was seconded by John Raub and passed by unanimous voice vote.

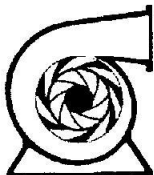
