1. Call To order (Pledge to the Flag)
2. Public Comment- Sign in sheet-Charlie Earl deferred till after meeting, Steve Lambert discussed the snow removal fines from Magistrate, but agreed the citations were needed to gain conformance.
3. Approval of Minutes
  - a. 1/29/2026 minutes- motion Tim Bruce and second by John Davis. Motion carried by ayes.
4. Current Vacancy on the Council- interested parties in attendance moved to end of the meeting. See Vacancy committee meeting minutes.
5. Letters to the borough – LDG on Prospect Street Bridge. Discussion on the bridge deficiency report. Bridge slated for renovation in 2027/2028.
6. Committee Reports
  - a. Finance Committee-approval of Bills, Any bills of notable cost-John Davis motion, seconded by Tim Bruce. Motion carried by ayes.
  - b. General Government Committee-Chair Tim Bruce, no meetings held.
  - c. Personnel Committee-Chair John Raub, updates on position vacancies: Council position, PT Police Officer, Ordinance Enforcement Officer. Boro Manger gave a report on this: Ordinance Officer on hold for now

pending discussion on ordinance updates. PT Police officers – Kyle Weisel picking up early morning patrols during week and some on weekends. New hire still under going processing through the MPOETC unknown when that will be completed.

- d. Protection of Persons and Property Committee-Chair - No meetings held.
- e. Streets and Sidewalks Committee-Chair Wayne Pratt- two meetings held Feb 11 and Feb 23. Minutes available. Chairman Wayne Pratt reported out. See attached minutes. Next meeting date not scheduled as of yet.
- f. Technology Committee-Chair Tim Bruce -Website in process of being updated. Under the new website notifications to residents about issues can be made via email.
- g. Water/Sewer Department Committee-Chair Vacancy, Feb 20<sup>th</sup> billing no issues, Three water leaks repaired: Weigester St. and Prospect St, Route 6/14 intersection under downtown light by Vinnies Pizzeria, and Upper High St between John St and King St. Solid Ground Specialist was brought to work the dig, while borough employees fixed the leak. As a result, DEP policy required parts of Troy to be under a boil advisory from Thursday until Weds evening when the final water samples testing results were received. Notification went out about the water advisory via website, wiggle, Facebook, and Troy Open Discussion page. Lifting of the Borough boil advisory was released the same way. A few phone calls or texts went out as well. Pamphlets were delivered by Borough employees to the effective residences.

Meeting held February 24 with the Finance committee. Topic included high end water usage by month or quarter. Discussion on high water usage fees to reflect the wear and tear on the system and repairs needed. A resolution was submitted for vote on increasing the rates by \$1 from basic water rate based on usage after 5000 gallons then at 20,000-gallon intervals. This to include \$25 late fee or 10% of bill which is lessor. Resolution attached to minutes. Motion to accept made by John Davis and seconded by Wayne Pratt. Motion carried by ayes.
